## PLAYING RULES

1. Length of game – 6<sup>th</sup> grade will play 12-minute halves. 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grades will play 14-minute halves. 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades will play 16-minute halves.
2. Clock – the clock will stop on all whistles. \*\*If a team is ahead by at least 20 points in the second half, the clock will run continuously.
3. Warm-up time will be three minutes in length, and halftime will also be three minutes in length.
4. Team fouls will begin on the 8<sup>th</sup> foul of the half. All 1-and-1 fouls thereafter. No double bonus. Personal fouls: 5 per player.
5. Game ball for girls and 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys will be a 28.5" women's ball. 9<sup>th</sup> grade boys will use a boys' ball. **Warm up balls will *not* be provided.**
6. Official brackets will be posted at the sites. Ask if you need help to find when and where you play.
7. Grace period – game time is game time!!! You will be given a 5 minute grace period.
8. Tournament director has right to change game site or game time at his/her discretion.  
**Tournament director has right to remove any player, coach, or fan who displays improper behavior.**
9. A team may start a game with less than five players.
10. First overtime period is two full minutes. Each overtime period after that is one minute.
11. Each team will receive four 30-second time outs. No extra time outs for overtime.
12. **Each team must provide a scorekeeper.** If the score keeper is not a coach they will be required to pay admission cost. Each team will work together to be the official book.
13. Admission: Adults, \$5.00 per day. Children, \$4.00 per day.
14. Doors open 30 minutes prior to game time, when your team plays the first game of the day.
15. The first team listed on the schedule is the home team, and the last team is the visitor.
16. If for any reason, including (but not limited to) power outages, tournament has to be canceled or cannot be completed, a \$100.00 processing fee will be held to cover expenses, plus \$50.00 per game played by your team. All teams playing 3 games will be considered as having participated in a completed tournament.
17. **All teams are allowed 2 coaches in for free. All others MUST pay. Coaches must wear their wristband the entire weekend. If they lose it or do not wear it, they must pay.**
